WMWA met on January 9, 2024 to discuss ongoing initiatives. The next meeting will be February 13.

#### Hennepin County Joint Education and Outreach Coordinator

Grace Barcelow presented a draft of the ArcGIS Survey123 form Hennepin County has been developing. The map-based form will be used by Grace and other water resource professionals as a guide when they meet with property owners to discuss winter salting and help them develop a more sustainable management strategy. The Survey123 form will be used in conjunction with the other resources developed by the Hennepin County Chloride Initiative and will help guide discussions with property owners, as well as keep a complete record of meetings and problem locations. Grace has been reaching out to faith-based communities in the watersheds to solicit interest in meetings to discuss chloride use. She hasn't had any luck so far given the busy holiday season but expects to get some responses back this month to schedule initial meetings in February.

Grace continues work on her other initiatives, including developing a Pet Waste Campaign and materials for WMWA's member cities to use, planning each watershed's water quality projects (i.e., resilient yards and shoreline workshops), and developing a combined calendar of outreach materials to guide community outreach and education for WMWA, Watershed Prep, cities, and Hennepin County.

Amy Juntunen is working on scheduling the next steering committee meeting that will guide the joint education and outreach coordinator's work in the coming year. The first steering committee meeting is expected in February.

#### Watershed Prep

WMWA educator Jessica is continuing to provide classroom lessons this winter, which usually has less interest than the fall and spring. She has a handful of classroom lessons planned for January and February before her schedule starts to get busy in the spring. The 2024 budget for the WMWA educator has been increased from 2023, allowing Jessica to reach more students and attend more additional community events like festivals and tabling events.

The Discover Plymouth event in late March was discussed at the WMWA meeting. WMWA will have a booth and will display educational materials, handouts, and native plant roots, as well as have native

seeds for visitors to take home. Jessica is not able to attend the event as she usually does, so Grace is attending in her place. Commission members from Bassett Creek Watershed Management Organization will volunteer, but all volunteers are welcome. ## Watershed Based Implementation Funding (WBIF)

The group briefly discussed whether there was interest in allocating some WBIF funding to help continue implementation of the Hennepin County Chloride Initiative's No Salt Low Salt campaign. It was agreed that the primary need was to fund staff assistance in facilitating meetings and coordinating strategies between the 11 watersheds and Hennepin County and whether it should be broadened to other entities in the Metro Area. More discussion will follow.
