Program was developed by Freshwater for the MPCA and the purpose of the program includes:

"... organize community action for the restoration and preservation of our water resources. Your Capstone Project is designed to demonstrate your leadership role in educating others and building local partnerships to successfully complete a water improvement project."

Capstone Project Overview:

Evaluate and revitalize Crystal's current 125 rain gardens and offer alternative runoff abatement methods to those without rain gardens. Project results includes:

- 1. Review and assess current rain garden conditions.
- Homeowner Help: If property owner wants to have rain gardens revitalized this Capstone project will provide help through offering plant plugs and/or plants and volunteer help to do the heavy lifting on a one-time basis along with ongoing, on-line education. Goal of project is to engage local scouts earning merit badges, local youth groups from churches and schools looking for volunteer opportunities.
- 3. Those without rain gardens will be provided with seed or plugs and simple to use (keeping things small) instructions on how to do things in your yard that will capture more rain water (and snow and runoff).
- 4. Easy to use, ongoing education on raingarden maintenance.
